The Emmetsburg City Council met on the above date in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Myrna Hedding calling the meeting to order and the following council members answering the roll call: Mike Hermansen, Brian Campbell, Todd Bell, Ryan Berkland, Brian Malm, and Bill Burdick.

**CONSENT AGENDA**

Motion carried to adopt the agenda as presented along with the following consent agenda: previous minutes of September 24, 2018; September 2018 Claims - \$194,639.59; Class B License Native Wine Permit - The Willow Tree Garden Center, LLC; Class C Liquor License, Outdoor Service, and Sunday Services - VFW Post #2295.
