Motion carried to adopt the agenda as presented along with the following consent agenda: approve previous minutes of January 10, 2022 and February 7, 2022; approve January 2022 claims of \$290,291.77; approve tax abatement for Randal L Swanson at 1401 Broadway; approve Class C liquor license, outdoor service, and Sunday sales of City of Emmetsburg; approve Class C liquor license, living quarters, outdoor service and Sunday sales for The Office; approve Class C beer, Class B wine permit, and Sunday Sales for Dollar General Store #7054.

It was introduced, seconded, and carried to approve Resolution 21-04, a resolution to certify debt against taxable property located at 1508 11th Street owned by Kyle Harding & Patricia Korte, Michael & Carnie Fitzgerald, Christy Fitzgerald for \$521.23.

Motion carried to authorize advertising and hiring for seasonal part-time help for Summer 2022.

Motion carried to approve Brian Malm and Jeff Morey for part-time seasonal Public Properties employees at \$15.00 per hour.

Motion carried to approve hiring Carmen Kaneer for part-time seasonal housekeeper at \$15 per hour.

Motion carried to approve hiring Krista Sundall (bartender/cook) and Alexis Hillesheim (bartender) for part-time Community Center employees.

After review of each department's budget proposals motion carried to approve the proposed changes to balance the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget revenues and expenditures.
