The Emmetsburg City Council met in the Poet Room of The Shores on the above date with Mayor Patrick Degen calling the meeting to order and the following council members answering the roll call: Corey Gramowski, Ryan Berkland, Mike Hermansen, Brian Malm, and Todd Bell.

**CONSENT AGENDA**

Motion carried to adopt the agenda as presented along with the following consent agenda: approve previous minutes of April 25, 2022; approve April 2022 claims of \$293,016.74; approve Class C liquor license, catering, and outdoor services for The Cornerstone Pub; approve FY 2022-23 cigarette/tobacco/nicotine/vapor permits for Dollar Fresh and Casey's.

Motion carried to approve hiring Lane Auten for part-time seasonal public properties employee at \$14 an hour.

Motion carried to approve Kianna Gloede for part-time seasonal community center employee at \$9 an hour.

Motion carried to approve Grant Kibbie for part-time seasonal community center employee at \$9 an hour.

**REPORT OF OFFICERS**

City Administrator Kim Kibbie reported on staffing at the community center and the waste water department. She also stated May 19, 2022 staff will participate in cleaning up around town.

Police Chief Ryan Veldboom shared the 2022 hybrid truck is now in service.

Community Center Director Alissa Kliegl provided recaps on golf memberships, weddings, and events.

Marketing & Retail Coordinator Gretchen Reichter shared pictures of the new brand for the City. She also stated that Justin and Abby Burns' grant application will be awarded for downtown upper story housing through the state.
